

RESOLUTION NO. An-4-13-23

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FINES FOR DOG VIOLATIONS FOR THE CITY OF HALFWAY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Halfway, adopted on March 09, 2023 Ordinance No. An. 0238, Series 2023 / Chapter 91 Ordinance for the Regulating of Animals within the City Limits of the City of Halfway.

WHEREAS, the state allows the City Council of the City of Halfway to establish a fine structure for animal violations.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Halfway shall periodically review the fine structure for animal violations to assure they are adequate for the City of Halfway, and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the following minimum fine structure be established, maximum fine not to exceed \$600.00 per offense but may be doubled if two offenses within One Year.

<u>Dog bites a person</u>	<u>\$250.00</u>
<u>Dog chases vehicle or persons (includes: walking, ATV, bicycles)</u>	<u>\$75.00</u>
<u>Dog damages or destroys the property of others</u>	<u>\$100.00</u>
<u>Dog scatters garbage</u>	<u>\$75.00</u>
<u>Dog disturbs any person by frequent or prolonged noises</u>	<u>\$75.00</u>
<u>Dog has not been vaccinated for rabies</u>	<u>\$60.00</u>
<u>Possession of unlicensed dog (per dog)</u>	<u>\$25.00</u>
<u>Dog chases livestock</u>	<u>\$125.00</u>
<u>Dog is dangerous</u>	<u>\$300.00</u>

Other: You will be required to go to court in Baker City for all tickets. If an animal bites twice the City will request it to be destroyed.

BE IT RESOLVED that these fines shall be effective immediately starting this 13th day of April, 2023 and shall remain in effect until such time that the City Council will review the above fines and make appropriate adjustments, if any.
